Selected Village of Westchester Ordinances

The Village of Westchester Ordinances prevail over the Association's Declaration of Covenants, Conditions, and Restrictions, and they include most standards of maintenance relevant to the Association. The Village of Westchester has the right to enter upon the Association owned streets to enforce all traffic laws. A few of such ordinances are as follows:

Please clean up after your pets.

Chapter 10.04.120 Dogs and Cats-Property Damage Unlawful

It is unlawful for any owner, keeper or walker of any dog or cat to permit his or her dog or cat to discharge such animals' excreta upon any public or private property, other than the property of the owner of such dog or cat, or property which the owner of any dog or cat has written permission to use, within the village if such owner, keeper, or walker does not immediately thereafter remove and clean up such from the public or private property.

Trash cans must be stowed by the evening of trash pick up. All trash cans must be screened from public view.

Chapter 8.04.100 Containers-Location

- b) Waste containers shall be placed at the curb line no earlier than seven p.m. on the day preceding the day of collection and removed from the curb line as soon as possible after collection, but no later than seven p.m. on the day of collection.

*Waste Management has requested that trash containers be separated by at least 2 feet for easy collection.

No Feeding of Wildlife

A friendly reminder from Village that it is unlawful to feed wild animals such as deer, stray dogs or cats. Wild animals, rodents, and birds may constitute a menace to public health and comfort and can also be offensive.
